# Iconic supermodels land in London

**New exhibition of the world's most beautiful women**

Marco Glaviano is a man who defines the term 'job satisfaction'. Since the mid-Seventies, the Sicilian has been at the forefront of fashion photography, and his stints at *Vogue*, *Elle* and *Vanity Fair* have seen him shoot some of the world's most attractive women in various states of undress.

Presumably – unless your job involves similar perks – this information isn't making your commute any easier. Well, here's the good news: Glaviano's tantalising portfolio is no longer consigned to private collections, bulky coffee-table books and hard-to-find magazine back
